It is a business, and it is unjust.

Their business is dependent on this entire perverse system continuing on. If they truly cared about society, they WOULD NOT EXIST. It is your responsibility to see that they don't exist in our State for much longer

That is why I am asking that you pass H5749, H5750, H5751.

The Wyatt needs to go. It's a blight on the State of Rhode Island and the City of Central Falls. I am asking you to please:

- Stop the state from allowing private or public-private prisons like the Wyatt.
- Stop incarcerated Rhode Islanders from being held in other states, and stop RI from holding people from out-of-state in RI prisons.
- Do not renew the contract that Rhode Island holds with the Wyatt Detention Center.
- Require unannounced safety inspections at the Wyatt twice a year until it closes (which should be the day that the CURRENT contract ends.
