## Introduced By Representative Bennett

This act would require the executive office of health and human services (EOHHS) to conduct a study to assess the impact of using Medicaid funds to provide coverage for the treatment of the chronically homeless.

This act would take effect upon passage.

## Legislation Committee finds this bill Beneficial if amended

Rather than studying the impact of using Medicaid funding of treatment of chronic homelessness, the bill should direct the Executive Office of Health and Human Services to submit a Medicaid Plan Amendment to include serving persons who are chronically homeless.
