COYOTE RI has conducted current research on sex trafficking and sex work surveying "people involved in the sex industry". The data has been archived at Brown University, Pembroke Centerfor Teaching and Research on Women- Coyote RI Survey Collection. Policy decisions should be based on evidence-based research. We encourage training inclusive of creating compassionate harm reduction policies based on evidence-based research and peer support.
