

To Chairwoman Williams & members of the committee,

I'd first like to commend Chairwoman Williams for introducing this growing fight in the labor movement. classifying domestic workers, such as in-home housekeepers or health aids so that they are not subject to basic labor law like the minimum wage is a great injustice that has for too long fallen under the radar. Most often, these workers are from some of the most marginalized communities: almost always low-income, and most often they are from BIPOC communities. Many are foreign-born, and they should not be exploited like this. This bill is another great piece of legislation that gives power back where it belongs, to working people, and I urge you to swiftly consider it for a vote.
