■ 3.0 Full Time Staff FY 2012: The Governor recommends \$330,855 for salaries and benefits -Reflects a medical benefits holiday and other technical corrections FY 2013: Fully funds with current benefit rates

Interpreter & CART Services

FY 2012 Governor recommends \$49,400, which is \$450 more than the enacted level Utilizes contract services for communication access - includes interpreter & CART services Funding exceeds historical expenditures ■*FY 2009 expenses* - \$41,610 ■*FY 2010 expenses* - \$43,059 FY 2011 expenses - \$46,833

Interpreter & CART Services

FY 2013 Governor recommends \$51,634, which is \$2,684 more than the enacted level

- Reflects additional use of interpreter services for the Commission due to new board members that require specialized translators.

Other Operations

 FY 2012 : The Governor recommends \$13,453 for all other operating expenses, \$5,273 more than enacted

FY 2013: The Governor recommends \$9,605 or \$1,425 more than enacted
