Responsibilities


- Established by State Constitution as one of the five general offices
 - Fulfills the executive responsibilities of the Governor upon death, resignation, impeachment or inability to serve


Responsibilities

Recommendation – *Municipal Incentive Grants*

- 2015 Executive Order on regionalization and consolidation efforts
 - Office of Lieutenant Governor to assist municipalities
- \$0.1 million for municipal incentive grants
 - Assistance to municipalities consistent with Executive Order
 - Budget does not include any additional guidance on use of funds

Recommendation – *Federal Grants*

- State Innovation Model Grant
 - Center for Medicare & Medicaid Services grant
 - Developing and testing state-based models for multi-payer medical claim payments
 - \$16,000 in FY 2015 to reflect unspent funds carried forward
 - \$65,000 for FY 2016
- Exchange Establishment One Grant expired on January 1, 2015

Recommendation – *Legal Services*

- Currently no staff attorney
- Office's second quarter report indicated need for \$40,000 of legal services not included in budget request
 - Outside counsel for PUC hearing concerning National Grid rate hike
 - \$7,500 spent so far in FY 2015
- Governor recommends \$40,000 for both FY 2015 and FY 2016

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
