DEFINITIONS:

Posted Bridge:

A bridge with specific posted weight limits in tons. All vehicles exceeding the specified weight limits are prohibited from crossing the bridge, inclusive of vehicles

that have an annual OSOW permit.

Emergency Vehicles (EVs):

provision, the gross vehicle weight (GVW) limits for EVs is 86,000 pounds with additional limitations of 24,000 pounds on a single steering axle; 33,500 pounds on a single drive axle; 62,000 pounds on a tandem axle; or 52,000 pounds on a tandem rear drive steer axle. Vehicles subject to this act are generally various fire apparatus. Pursuant to Section 1410 of the FAST Act (U.S. Congress, The Fixing America's Surface Transportation Act (P.L. 144-94)), emergency vehicles are designed to be used under emergency conditions to transport personnel and equipment to suppress fires and mitigate other hazardous situations (23 U.S.C. 127(r)(2)). REPORT NOTES:

1. For posted bridges without EV tonnage values provided in this report, the weight limits for EV vehicles shall be the tonnage values given for the applicable number of axles (i.e. "two axle", "three axle", etc).

2. Blank tonnage values under the "Posted Loads" of this report indicate there is no legal load restriction for that particular axle configuration unless a "Straight" posting is designated. In that case,

the "Straight" posting shall be used for any number of axles.

-"S" = Specialized Hauling Vehicles. These are closely spaced multi-axle single unit trucks. Examples include special hauling vehicles such as dump trucks, construction vehicles, solid waste trucks, and other hauling trucks.

He said the replacement of the traffic signal with a roundabout would provide a Level of Service of A, which indicates free-flowing traffic conditions. Mr. Bambara said the queues were calculated to be less than 50 ft for all approaches to the roundabout. Sean Raymond said roundabouts are considered to be a proven safety countermeasure by the Federal Highway Administration and have been shown to reduce emissions and they typically incure less maintenance costs as compared to traffic signals. Chief Moynihan asked Mr. Bambara if crash data was analyzed. Mr. Bambara said crash data was reviewed and most crashes were rear-end type. Mr. Bambara also said the placement of the proposed roundabout would be located away from the Pier and would increase sight distance.
