Dear Chairman Shanley,

Thank you for providing the Department of Environmental Management (DEM) the opportunity to comment on H 6383, which would establish new permit requirements for projects located in environmental justice focus areas. DEM supports efforts to more proactively address environmental justice in state government.

Environmental justice (EJ) refers to the fair treatment and meaningful involvement of all people regardless of race, color, national origin, or income with respect to the development, implementation, and enforcement of environmental laws, regulations, and policies. Throughout Rhode Island's history, certain populations and areas of the state have been subject to disproportionate amounts of pollution and other environmental hazards and have not had equal access to benefits. DEM is committed to finding solutions that will consider these past injustices and ensure that all residents of Rhode Island benefit from a clean, healthy environment.

Promoting EJ requires that state government work closely with residents of impacted communities to develop policies that address past inequities and prevent such inequities in the future. H 6383 presents useful concepts towards doing so by providing opportunities for public participation, requiring that cumulative impacts be considered during permit application reviews, and increasing the importance of public health considerations and community support in the review process. However, one concern is that the bill does not provide additional resources that DEM will need to implement these new requirements.

We appreciate the opportunity to offer comments on this legislation and would be pleased to work with you to address the issues raised in this letter.
