Chairman Solomon and members of the House Corporations Committee, Thank you for allowing me to submit this written testimony against House bill H-7556.

A 100% Disabled American Veteran that qualifies and has a DAV license plate already has all the rights of a disabled person I/A/W RIGL 31-28-7(h) (1). If the DAV were to ride in a different vehicle, with a regular license plate, they would need a disability privilege placard to be displayed on this vehicle.
