To RI House Corporations,

I strongly support H7353 and would like to see it become law in RI. <u>H7353</u> requests that Rhode Island Energy submit a proposal for new multi-year electric vehicle programming to the Public Utilities Commission. Given that transportation is the largest source of Greenhouse Gas (GHG) emissions in Rhode Island, RIE's EV programming will be a key piece of Rhode Island's approach to meeting the emissions reduction mandate of the Act on Climate. Recognizing this important role, many have worked across the RI Government and Industry to ensure key elements of RIE EV programs include results adequate for emissions reduction.

Key elements of the bill include...

- 1. Make Ready and EV Charging Station Incentives in *All* Segments, with greater incentives for low-income individuals
