The Alliance for Climate Transition appreciates the opportunity to submit comments in opposition to House Bill 6201: Renewable Energy Standard—Nuclear Energy.

The Alliance for Climate Transition ("ACT") leads the just, equitable, and rapid transition to a clean energy future and a diverse climate economy. Our 300+ members include companies from all of the clean energy market segments, many of whom are based in Rhode Island, do business here, or hope to make future investments in the state.

While we understand the pressure for the state to produce more energy to meet its Renewable Portfolio Standard ("RPS") goals, nuclear energy does not belong in this category, as it is produced using non-renewable resources.

Furthermore, nuclear energy is much more cost-intensive up front to develop than most renewables, making it a less viable pathway towards ensuring short-term and long-term energy bill relief for ratepayers in the state.
