As currently drafted, the bill would impose substantial costs on commercial property owners, particularly small businesses, and may present challenges during both new construction and renovation projects.

We would welcome the opportunity to work with you and the bill sponsors to refine the legislation in a way that advances its safety objectives while minimizing unnecessary costs and unintended impacts on Rhode Island's business community.
