The Rhode Island Water Works Association (RIWWA) is a professional trade organization that represents water supplies of the State of Rhode Island.

We are in support of House Bill 7781 introduced by Representatives Finkelman, Baginski, DeSimone, and Noret.

Relocation of utilities under current law (24-8.1-2) places a burden on municipal and quasi-municipal public utilities that provide public water service to its customers without regard for 1) availability of funding; 2) current plans and construction already undertaken by the utilities; 3) probable conflict with short, medium and long term planning by the utilities; 4) as well as ignoring necessary and advisable permitting and approval processes for many of the utilities subject to RI State Water Resources Board, RIDOH, and EPA rules, and regulations.

Many of the state roadway projects that 24-8.1-2 applies to are federally funded. Requiring a local utility to contribute to a project that is already fully funded may interfere with the outside funding for the overall project and additionally is demanding a financial contribution for something that RIDOT already has adequate funding for.

RIWWA fully supports House Bill H 7871 which would amend 24-8.1-2 as it applies to utilities and removes the burdensome unexpected and unnecessary costs to our local public utilities.
