Expecting a school day to continue on as if nothing has happened is not best practice. Students and colleagues should be allowed time and space to grieve. And they should definitely not be required to take a sick day or miss class to attend the funeral.

I urge passage of this bill so that the next time a district experiences this, they will be able to focus on the people in their district, and not be worried about the procedure.
