

Testimony in support of H. B. 5216: Pesticide Control

To Chair McNamara and the honorable Members of the House Education Committee:

I support H5216 because it will reduce pesticide, herbicide and rodenticide use and restrict their accessibility in schools, pre-schools and child-care centers, while investigating health risks associated with poly-fluoroalkyl substances (PFAS) in artificial athletic fields by...

- prohibiting use of Glyphosate,
- requiring local school authorities to annually provide an integrated pest management plan,
- requiring the department of health to provide schools with an explanation and the requirements of the pesticide application and notification la
- regulating storage of pesticides,
- and establishing a task force to specifically address the presence of, and potential health risks associated with the presence of PFAS in artificial athletic fields. The latter is of particular current relevance, because of the growing evidence of long-term and broad toxicity of even low levels of PFAS, especially for toddlers, children and teenagers, and the still insufficient public awareness about these dangers.

Please bring the bill to a vote in the House in 2025, to protect our children from toxic substances in their schools' environment. The measures in the bill are common sense. Implementing them is relatively straightforward, and not too much to ask for to prevent accidents from happening and to ultimately protect health and lives of those whom we love the most.

Unfortunately, the bill did not come to a vote in 2024, and passing it into law in this year, 2025, is the responsible action to take. Please do not risk harming a child by waiting another year!
