

Written Testimony in Support of Rhode Island Bill 5842: Fairness in Women's Sports

Dear Members of the Rhode Island General Assembly,

I write to express my support for Bill 5842, the “Fairness in Women’s Sports Act.” This bill seeks to ensure that female athletes in our state have the opportunity to compete on a level playing field—one that honors the intent and protections of Title IX, which was designed to create equal opportunities for women and girls in education and athletics.
