I have seen first hand students leaving the school to go to charters. This is limiting our resources and lowering our enrollment. Providence's budget is \$36,000,000 to charters where we could use that money to support our special needs students and classes. MLL students and special education students are not being supported properly because of the lack of resources and lack of support that are left behind. This bill will lead to more accountability on the charters in terms of academic outcomes and financials.
