Testimony from Emil "Dean" Fachon, East Greenwich **In support of H7295**, The Rhode Island Clean Air Preservation Act

To the House Committee for Environment and Natural Resources,

Despite a high degree of uncertainty in climate-forecasting, the 'White House Document on Solar Radiation Modification (SRM)' proposes to deliberately pollute the atmosphere to combat climate change.
