Distinguished Members of the Committee,

We submit this testimony in opposition to Bill 7562 which proposes to deleted subsection (b) of RIGL S 20-16-1 for the following reasons:

- RI DEM acts as an agent of the State and is entrusted with the management of the listed protected species on behalf of the people of Rhode Island. Removing these species from protected status as a matter of statute materially alters the protections that should be afforded to them, and that could be afforded to them under the alternative regulatory scheme being proposed.
- The current language of the statute does not prohibit RI DEM from enacting rules and regulations concerning the hunting and management of these species and so any change to this statute should be viewed critically.

We appreciate the Committee's time and efforts, and encourage you to oppose the enactment of this legislation.
