RE: House Bill No. <u>5294 -</u> AN ACT RELATING TO AGRICULTURE AND FORESTRY -- OLD GROWTH FOREST PROTECTION ACT

Dear Chairman Bennett,

Thank you for providing the Department of Administration, Division of Statewide Planning (RIDSP) the opportunity to comment on 2025-H-5294. This bill would create a new program called "the natural heritage program" within the RIDSP and mandate that the State Planning Council (SPC) provide oversight of extractive logging operations and prescribed burn operations in all state or municipally owned forests over one acre.

We appreciate the intent of this legislation and the sponsor's focus on protecting Rhode Island's forests. Presently, RIDEM has the responsibility and expertise in forestry, and we are concerned that the bill would subject a sister agency's actions to oversight by our SPC, which functions as a policy council not a permitting agency. The bill would create onerous and redundant data gathering, inventory and reporting issues, extensive and expensive public notice requirements, and additional meeting and hearing requirements for the SPC. In addition, the bill would create an appeal process for SPC decisions to Superior Court that would require additional funding for legal expertise, time and other expenses.

The RIDSP would require substantial resources beyond the one full time employee proposed to implement this legislation as envisioned.

Again, we appreciate the opportunity to offer comments on this legislation and will make ourselves available as needed.
