Dear Chairman Bennett:

The undersigned members of the Rhode Island Business Coalition write in support of H.5846, An Act Relating to Health and Safety – State Building Code. We thank Representative Cortvriend for introducing this legislation to ensure stability regarding the code requirements for the next several years.

Rhode Island became the first state in the nation to adopt the 2024 International Energy Conservation Code (IECC), which was supported by members of the environmental and development communities alike.

H.5846 would establish a moratorium on any changes through January 1, 2030. This would provide a predictable window of time to deploy resources and train the workforce to implement the advancements made without the risk of intervening changes.

Thank you for your consideration of our position and we ask the committee to support H.5846.
