The ERP project will modernize how the state does business with respect to human resources and finance operations, standardizing:

- Time tracking, hiring process, and payroll
- Accounting, receivables/payables, and reporting
- Integration with other enterprise systems




In addition to annual maintenance and operation funding beginning halfway through FY25, Governor McKee has **recommended 6 FTEs** across the Human Resources and Accounts and Control Divisions, in line with best practices for similar projects across the country.
