JOINT RESOLUTION MAKING AN APPROPRIATION OF \$500,000 TO THE UNITED WAY OF RHODE ISLAND FOR THE 2-1-1 HUMAN SERVICES HOTLINE

As Mayor of Pawtucket, I write in strong support of **House Resolution No. 5234**, which would appropriate \$500,000 to support the continued operation of **United Way of Rhode Island's 211**, a statewide lifeline connecting residents to critical health and human services.

In 2024, 211 responded to nearly **213,000 calls, texts, emails, and walk-ins** from Rhode Islanders, including **2,900** calls right here in **Pawtucket,** where residents most frequently reached out for help with **housing, food and utilities**.

As local leaders, we see firsthand how critical it is to have a trusted, accessible resource like 211 that can help residents navigate crises and find stability. With looming federal cuts to safety net programs, our communities will rely on 211 more than ever.

House Resolution No. 5234 is a sound investment in public health, safety, and stability—one that ensures residents in every city and town can access the help they need, when they need it most.
