We strongly **support House Bill 5742** because **we are deeply concerned about the persisting issue of food insecurity in Rhode Island, which is a critical social determinant of health**. According to the RI Life Index, the level of food insecurity remains alarmingly high, with 38% of households with children reporting that they cannot afford adequate food.¹ It's crucial to note that not all of these households qualify for free school meals under federal guidelines. This pressing issue needs immediate attention, as children should be focusing on their next math quiz, not worrying about their next meal.

Inadequate nutrition has a significant impact on a child's health, educational achievement, and economic well-being. It not only leads to chronic disease and emotional distress but also hampers their ability to move out of poverty and improve the prospects of future generations.²

By ensuring that all Rhode Island children have access to consistent nutrition, this legislation will be a major step forward in eliminating health and education inequities, safeguarding against chronic food insecurity, and paving the way for a healthier and more prosperous future for all Rhode Islanders.

Healthy children mean a healthier future for all of Rhode Island. We urge the Committee's support for health school meals for all children.
