

DISPARITIES IN YOUTH MENTAL HEALTH

THE NEED TO SUPPORT S.0250 / H.6045

Children and youth with mental health conditions are at increased risk for suicide.

In 2022 **more than half (59%)** of children ages 3 to 17 in Rhode Island who needed mental health treatment or counseling **had a problem obtaining needed care.**

In 2023, **36%** of Rhode Island high school students **reported feeling sad or hopeless** for more than two weeks during the past year.

Twelve children ages 15 to 19 **died due to suicide** in Rhode Island between 2018-2022.

In 2022, more than **one in four (28.7%)** children ages 3 to 17 **had a mental, emotional, or behavioral health problem** in Rhode Island.

Children living in poverty are **two to three times more likely to develop mental health conditions** than their peers.
