Dear Chairman and Committee Members,

On behalf of the Immigrant Coalition and our 38 member organizations, I ask this Committee to support House Bill 5745, which would reduce the time required for students to meet the residency requirement from 3 years to 6 months for in-state tuition, regardless of immigration status.

An immigrant is no less of a Rhode Islander than someone from, say, California. We see no reason in having a bias based on immigration status, with citizens having a requirement of one year and non-citizens three years. We believe 6 months is a fair and sufficient time for anyone to be considered for in-state tuition.

The current state of affairs increases inequality. We urge this Committee to stand with us and increase fair access to education for all in Rhode Island.
