On behalf of the Immigrant Coalition and our 38 member organizations, I ask this Committee to support House Bill H5982, which would create a dual language program fund administered by RIDE for districts to start, expand, and improve PK-12 dual language programs.

Over 40% of students in Rhode Island's urban districts speak a language other than English at home. Expanding bilingual education ensures all students—regardless of background—can thrive academically and professionally. Research shows that bilingual education leads to stronger academic outcomes for both multilingual learners and English-dominant students, making it the gold standard in education.

We urge this Committee to stand with us and invest in the success of Rhode Island students.
