Whether working in Providence and Central Falls, or Newport and Middletown, we have experienced the importance of supporting multilingual learners and promoting multilingualism in the broader population . We are more effective partners due to our multilingual staff at CYCLE and language diversity is something we should be investing in and celebrating in Rhode Island.

H5744 would strengthen our state's teacher corps to support post-secondary students and practicing teachers to gain certification in areas of ESL, dual language, bilingual, and world language instruction.
