**Re: Support for Article 9; ReBuildRI Tax Credits**

Dear Chairman Abney:

The Rhode Island Building and Construction Trades Council is comprised of sixteen (16) Local Trade Unions and approximately 10,000 members. On behalf of the officers and members, I am writing in **SUPPORT** of the above referred to budget Article for the reasons that follow.

This budget article extends the sunset provisions on the Rhode Island Commerce's programs Qualified Jobs tax credit program and the Rebuild Rhode Island tax credit. These programs are usually allocated to larger local construction projects that have a significant economic impact to our state that extends beyond capital improvements. Such projects are the life blood of the union construction industry. Thousands of local skilled union craftsmen and women that depend on a continuation of these projects in order to support their careers and their families are indirectly depending on these incentives. These tools are not only important to them, but to our entire economy also.

Because of collaboration between state government and construction industry during COVID the industry never shut down throughout the pandemic. This resulted in the construction industry and by extension our greater economy to develop economic momentum. Maintaining these incentives will allow momentum for both to continue.
