## RE: H 7886 An Act Relating to Animals and Animal Husbandry - Cruelty to Animals

Dear Chairwoman Donovan,

Thank you for providing the Department of Environmental Management (DEM) the opportunity to comment on H 7886, which would prohibit any manufacturer from selling any cosmetic product that was developed or manufactured using an animal test. DEM has concerns with this legislation.

DEM appreciates that the intent of this legislation is to improve animal welfare, but we are concerned that it does not detail how it would be implemented by state government. Because the legislation seeks to amend Title 4, which generally includes statutes which are implemented by DEM, we are concerned that DEM would be responsible for enforcing the prohibition on the sale of cosmetic products tested on animals. Enforcement of a prohibition of this nature would require us to investigate the compliance status of the many different cosmetic products currently available for sale in Rhode Island. Such an investigation is outside DEM's current scope of duties and would significantly diminish our capacity to respond to other animal cruelty investigations. Therefore, we recommend that any legislation on this topic consider an enforcement mechanism that is complaint-driven rather than requiring DEM staff to conduct proactive inspections of retailers selling cosmetic products.
