Dear Chair Donovan, First Vice Chair Giraldo, Second Vice Chair Potter, and Members of the Health and Human Services Committee,

I have sent this message to urge you to support House Bill 5865. This bill bans the sale of cosmetics developed/manufactured using animal testing and would impose a fine in the amount of \$1,000 for each violation.

As a long-time member of the chemical manufacturing industry - senior manufacturing chemist in the pharmaceutical industry and previously specialty chemicals industry - I can tell you that the testing of such products using animals is both unnecessary and unacceptably harmful to the animal subjects who suffer from such testing.

RI should take advantage of this opportunity to join the eleven states (California, Hawaii, Illinois, Louisiana, Maine, Maryland, Nevada, New Jersey, New York, Oregon, and Virginia) which, for good reason, have already banned the sale of animal-tested cosmetics.
