These children have been diagnosed with Autism Spectrum Disorders. Through ongoing tracking and assessment, the treatment is continuously adapted to foster the child's skill development. ABA helps children to learn positive behaviors, enhance social awareness, increase language usage, and further their emotional development. Of course, the stability of the child lends to the stability of the entire family.

I want to thank the General Assembly for raising Medicaid rates for ABA. It is also very important for commercial insurers to maintain competitive payments to ensure a stable system of service.
