**Re: H5848 - An Act Relating to Human Services – Community Health Centers**

Dear Chairwoman Donovan and Members of the House Health and Human Services Committee:

The Rhode Island Health Center Association supports House Bill 5848.

We thank Representative Hopkins for introducing the bill and acknowledge the bill's sponsors.

HB 5848 recognizes the importance of community health centers to both the RI Department of Health (RIDOH) and the Executive Office of Health and Human Services (EOHHS).

Community health centers are the vehicles through which many of RIDOH's initiatives are accomplished. Two examples are community health center participation in RIDOH's cancer screening and blood lead testing efforts.

EOHHS relies on the community health centers to provide high quality primary medical, behavioral, and dental care to 1 of every 3 Medicaid eligible individuals.

We support the bill's directive to both these agencies to work with the community health centers to identify ways to strengthen these vital safety-net providers.

We are very pleased to see the explicit mention of the Teaching Health Center Graduate Medical Education (THC-GME), as we believe Rhode Island's primary care residency programs should shift to more community health centers. This bill and HB5526 will ensure Thundermist's THC - GME effort is funded.
