

## Testimony in Opposition to H7632

Dear Members of the Committee:

I am writing to respectfully voice my opposition to H7632, the “Age Appropriate Design Code”. The requirements for data protection impact assessments (pages 5 through 8) are compelled speech under the *Zauderer* standard, as the 9th Circuit recognized in striking down the DPIA requirements in California’s Age Appropriate Design Code. See *Netchoice v. Bonta* No. 23-2969 (9th Cir. 2024). One should not address the important issue of young people using social media by starting with an approach that the courts have already thrown out.
