Police rarely charge anyone involved in these transactions, but I strongly believe the buyers should be charged because they cause a massive amount of harm. They buy us to hurt us.

I oppose HB 7307 because it protects buyers, as though they are innocent bystanders when they routinely damage our bodies and minds.

Once again, you are portraying a fantasy world when the reality is: commercial sex is rife with violence, mainly committed by the buyers, who typically have families, nice houses, and disposable income.

They do not need free passes. They need accountability.
