H7051: I oppose this bill because it doesn't appear to take into account in any manner grandfathering in a shooting range, should any new schools be built within the restricted area of 1 mile circumference. If, for safety reasons, we want firearm owners to be able to practice and maintain a high standard of competence with their firearms, then they need someplace to do that. Finding a way to restrict and eventually eliminate gun ranges is just another way of trying to make it difficult for people to shoot. Please **OPPOSE H7051**.
