I am writing on behalf of the Rhode Island Shield Bill Coalition in strong support of H7577, the Health Provider Shield Bill.

This coalition is hosted by the Rhode Island Medical Society (RIMS). Kicking off in January 2024, it came together based on requests from RIMS members and other providers who were concerned about the impact that hostile laws in other states may have on their ability to practice in Rhode Island.

In just over two months the coalition has more than 30 organizational members. Central to the Coalition are provider groups, which include groups representing medical students, nurses, physician assistants, social workers, nurse practitioners, and physicians across multiple specialties including primary care and other specialists. Passage of this bill not only protects providers and individual patients, but it protects the larger system by ensuring Rhode Island is able to recruit and retain providers into the future. This is particularly important given the legal protections in our neighboring states.
