We have random shots fired frequently in the Southside. Just this past week at the corner of Updike and Moore. Two years ago, two houses on my block were shot. The police are constantly seizing unregistered firearms from the Southside streets, often associated with after hour nightclub activity.

Gun violence is a public health epidemic in the US. No other developed country lives like we do, in fear of gun violence in our malls, movie theaters, places of worship, schools, restaurants and more.

Research shows that states with stricter gun laws have lower levels of gun violence, and we must be doing all we can to keep our families and communities safe.

Gun violence is the #1 killer of children and teens in our country and that is beyond unacceptable.

If more guns made us safer, we'd be the safest country in the world. Instead the US has a gun homicide rate that is 26 times higher than that of other high-income countries.

Thank you for your consideration of this important legislation.
