Dear Chairman Craven and House Judiciary Committee Members:

I am in support of H 7049, as I feel this will help The Rhode Island housing crisis and allow for families to have a place to call home.

The bill outlines the following:

- 1. Affordable housing: Ensuring housing is affordable and accessible, especially for low-income families and individuals.
- 2. Stable and predictable housing: Providing tenants with more stability and predictability around rental costs and housing situations.
- 3. Equal opportunity to housing: Ensuring all Rhode Island residents, including those with developmental disabilities and intellectual/developmental disabilities (IDD), have the same opportunities to access quality, affordable housing.

Ensuring equitable access to affordable, stable housing is crucial for supporting vulnerable communities in Rhode Island. The provisions in this bill appear designed to work towards these important housing equity goals. Please pass H 7049.
