On behalf of our members, supporters, and board members, I am respectfully requesting that you vote in favor of House Bill No. 5447 by Representative Serpa and cosponsored by Representatives Edwards, O'Brien, Baginski, Solomon, Kazarian, and Lima.

The Act would prohibit the sale, offer of sale, trade or distribution of fur products as defined and would make violations punishable by a civil fine.

In the U.S., Los Angeles, San Francisco, Berkeley, and West Hollywood banned new fur sales paving the way for California to become the first state in 2019. Cities in Massachusetts, Michigan and Florida have since passed similar legislation.

It is publicly known that horrific animal cruelty is involved in making fur products.
