RE: 2025 H 5643 (An Act Relating to State Affairs and Government – Casino Gaming)

Dear Chair Craven:

I am writing on behalf of the Rhode Island Lottery to express support with the above-captioned legislation, which would amend the casino crimes law to be consistent with the advent of iGaming and applicable age restrictions related to iGaming participation.

The Rhode Island Lottery strongly supports enforcement of age restrictions to ensure that casino gaming activities are limited to those individuals who are legally of age to engage in such conduct. With the recently enabled iGaming product, players who have not reached twenty-one (21) years of age are prohibited from engaging in iGaming as required by the iGaming enabling legislation. To dissuade prohibited conduct, the proposed bill simply codifies that engaging in iGaming by underage individuals or facilitating an underage individual to engage in iGaming is a criminal violation subject to appropriate penalties. Notably, this proposed legislation mirrors the existing criminal laws related to prohibiting underage engagement for other casino gaming products. Accordingly, the Rhode Island Lottery endorses passage of this legislation.
