### **RE: 2025 – H 6089 An Act Relating to Animal and Animal Husbandry – Cruelty to Animals**

Dear Chair Craven:

I am writing regarding **H 6089**, which increases imprisonment penalties and adds mandatory community service for violations of § 4-1-9.

BHDDH concurs that the abuse, neglect of animals requires appropriate judicial response. While BHDDH fully supports efforts to prevent animal abuse, this bill as currently drafted does not consider the complex behavioral health conditions which frequently underlie animal abuse. Behavioral health disorders that directly contribute to the mistreatment or neglect of animals should be addressed by the alternative of appropriate behavioral health treatment. Such treatment would have as its goal the alleviation of the condition(s) that has resulted in the allegations of abuse and/or death of an animal from abuse. Imprisonment or substantial fines will not serve as a deterrent or change the behavior of an individual whose harmful actions with respect to animals are solely due to a behavioral health condition.

A comprehensive mental health assessment conducted by a licensed mental health professional may result in the development of an appropriate intervention plan involving the coordinated efforts of multiple community-based behavioral healthcare and other service providers.

Staff within the Division of Behavioral Health at BHDDH would be happy to participate in efforts to develop an evidence-based response model that accommodates concerns about the abuse of animals.
