Regarding the upcoming vote on H-5436.

After a carefully reading of H-5436 I can only conclude this is bill is essentially an attempt to ban/confiscation of all firearms in Rhode Island.

Even the bills name is misleading - "Rhode Island Assault Weapons Ban Act of 2025". The term "assault weapon" is used to promote the idea that these weapons are exceptionally dangerous and are weapons of war. Currently true "assault weapons" are true automatic weapons. But the salient point is that an assault weapon can be anything used to do harm to another. These weapons may include fire arms, edged weapons (knives), blunt instruments, and hands and feet. The FBI ranks murder weapons as #1 firearms (hand guns), #2 knives, #3 hands, feet, fists. #4 rifles.

While H-5436 appears to apply mostly to long guns, many of its provisions also apply to modern hand guns. Especially semiautomatic hand guns.

A bit of history: Lincoln shot with a single shot derringer. McKinley shot with a .32 pistol Garfield shot with a pistol Archduke F. Ferdinand shot with a 9mm pistol RFK shot with a .22 caliber pistol John Lennon, Mayor Willie Mascone, Harvey Milk, Indira Gandhi, Lee Harvey Oswald, Mahatma Gandhi all shot with .38 caliber pistols. Reagan shot with a .22 caliber pistol.

In short, this bill is an affront to the 2nd Amendment of the US constitution and to all law abiding citizens of Rhode Island who legally own firearms and use them responsibly for lawful purposes, such as hunting, target/sport shooting and self defense.

I urge you and the committee to vote against H-5436
