Dear RI Freedom Collective Members;

I hope you're doing fine. I'm writing you this letter, to express my concern on how important the Second Look Act is for RI inmates, doing consecutive life sentence like me and others.

The RI Second Look Act, for long term- incarcerated individual, will provide the RI Court, to review the incarcerated individual document, live testimony or any other class of evidence or information pertinent to sentencing, including;

1. The factors of the argument and evidence presented at the hearing

2. The petitioner will have the right to a counsel

3. The petitioner will have the right to appeal

4. The victim family will have the right to be present at any hearing and provide any argument

A review of the Rule 35, RI Motion to Reduce sentence, cases in RI jurisdiction, the hearing Justice has denied numerous Motion on the ground that any support evidence of RIDOC, good behavior and rehabilitation records is for the RI Parole Board not for the Court to review.

In RI other incarcerated individual charge with first degree murder don't have the right for a sentence reduction hearing, and the Second Look Act will provide the Court with a chance to review the incarcerated individual good behavior, all rehabilitative effort completed and any support letters by family, friends and community members.

In my case, I was found guilty on <u>01-28-2002</u>, and sentence on <u>05-06-2002</u>. See, State v. <u>Pedro Reyes</u>, Case #, <u>P1-2001-3193AG</u> for further

information.

For the reason above, I <u>Pedro J. Reyes Muriel</u>, respectfully ask the Members of the RI Freedom Collective to read my letter to the RI Legislators on the date of the view of the Bill.
