**RE: 2026 H-7353 AN ACT RELATING TO MOTOR AND OTHER VEHICLES – CCPRA- POLICE RELATIONSHIP ACT OF 2015**

Dear Chairperson, McEntee:

Thank you for the opportunity to submit this letter of concern regarding H-7353.

The Rhode Island Department of Transportation (RIDOT) fully supports efforts to advance equity and fairness in transportation policy. However, our primary role under state law is the construction and maintenance of Rhode Island's transportation infrastructure. The objectives of this legislation would be more effectively managed by an agency with core expertise in civil rights, inclusion, and diversity.

Additionally, previous studies related to Comprehensive Community-Police Act (CPRA) were funded through a National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) grant to RIDOT. While some funds remain, they are insufficient to complete the required study, and future federal funding for such projects is uncertain. Given the uncertainty with future federal funds for projects of this nature, we are very concerned that this project could have a funding issue in its current form. If guaranteed additional Federal funds from NHTSA are not available, we do not have adequate funding to support this legislation.

We encourage the committee to consider both the need for dedicated funding and the alignment of responsibilities to ensure the best outcome for this initiative.
