BAN 287G AGREEMENTS

This act would **bar state and local police from joining federal immigration enforcement programs, limit holding people on detainers without judicial warrants**, and require tracking and reporting of requests.

Federal agents and entities should never be above the law, and we have the responsibility of protecting our citizens from this overreach of power

Validated under the 1996 Illegal Immigration Reform and Immigrant Responsibility Act, 287g agreements take on three main forms:

- Jail Enforcement Model (JEM): Local enforcement agencies can question people arrested about their immigration status
- Warrant Service Officer (WSO): Jail staff can serve ICE administrative warrants.
- Task Force Model: Allows street-level policing with ICE authority, such as traffic stops.

This act would banish all forms of federal and local ICE cooperation.
