Dear Committee Clerk DiMezza,

This creates additional work and expense on a property owner for a very small amount of money. In my experience this is just not an issue, landlords are usually willing to accommodate a tenant needing some additional time. Please do not pass this.

I oppose H7130, which allows tenants to pay an increase in a security deposit over a year.

Rent increases are usually small, and this would require a lot of extra bookkeeping and tracking for a pretty small dollar amount.

It also means that for part of the lease, a landlord would have less than one month's rent security deposit, which is unfair.

I don't think the increased burden on landlords is justified for the small dollar amounts. For example, a rent increase of \$50 would mean the landlord has to track a \$4.17 payment each month.

I hope that you agree that legislating payments of a few dollars a month over a year is excessive, and vote not to advance this bill.
