I oppose House Bill 8111, which would allow lawfully evicted adults to seal their records an unlimited number of times if a minor is named in the eviction proceedings. The name of the minor should be eliminated but the names of the adults should not be sealed.

When renting an apartment it is important for a landlord to know the prior eviction history of an applicant. If an applicant has been evicted in the last 5 years or has been evicted multiple times it is important for the landlord to know it. It is also an important factor in protecting the other tenants in a property as well.

This bill would be very harmful to property owners and other tenants in a building.

Please do not pass this bill.
