Dear House Judiciary Committee,

I am writing in support of 26-H 8077, which would create reasonable safeguards around the installation and use of automated license plate reader cameras in Rhode Island.

I live in the Doyle Ave neighborhood, and just became aware that there are at least six cameras in my neighborhood, all within a couple of blocks of my house. It seems that these cameras are placed mostly at places of gathering for the local community -- parks, schools, and churches. While these may have been installed with good intentions, I worry about their use by ICE and other groups who are currently operating outside the bounds of the law. I have neighbors who are immigrants, and who come from immigrant families, and I don't want them to have yet another reason to be discouraged from supporting their health, receiving an education, or engaging in community.

I would advocate entirely for the removal of these cameras and especially for the discontinuation of contracts with Flock, but as a starting point we need regulation in place to allow our neighbors to feel safe in their own homes.
