Also known as FLOCK Cameras, these monitoring devices have the ability to monitor people in their daily travels. And, if used inappropriately, could be used to coordinate with ICE to locate immigrants and aid in their capture.

I am deeply concerned that this technology is being used across our state without regulation and urge you to take action to protect our privacy in our state. The data sharing capabilities of these cameras is troubling, and I believe we need legal constraints in place.
